



# General information for international students WS 2024/25

#### 1. Visa

It is not possible to study in Germany with a tourist visa. It cannot be converted into a student visa after the entry. To receive a student visa, the student must present an admission letter of our university and a proof of sufficient funding (block account), Therefore, it is necessary to apply very early, because it can take (up to) few months until the visa is granted.

A soft copy of admission letter is sufficient. If you have applied through UNISONO you can download your admission letter.

The University is well aware that during this time of year many students are applying for visa so it is difficult to get visa appointments but please note that we cannot help you with visa appointments. Same is for the visa. Please do not contact us in this regard or/and ask about visa status.

#### 2. Block account

Block account is an account, where you are only able to get fixed amount of money every month.

Always make sure that when you deposit the money for block account is it the right amount, it is the amount required for block account and the charges of the bank. The bank will deduct the amount from the money you deposited so if the requirement for student visa is for example 8000 Euros and bank fee is 100 Euros submit 8100 Euros in your bank account.

Some of the students would be taking loans from banks for their studies, please note that the university cannot issue any letters for the issuing of this loan but if you need the proof of finance, you can download it from the following link

### 3. Finances

There are **NO** scholarships available for freshman. As far as jobs are concerned, you are allowed to do mini job along with your studies which is 240 half day or 120 full days during a year. Please remember you require basic German language skills and since you are moving to a new country and new education system, we recommend that you focus on your studies, at least for the first semester.

In Germany, there is a special mandatory long-term care insurance which cannot be covered by a Non-German Health Insurance. We, therefore, recommend signing a travel insurance in order to

Lecture Period: October 7<sup>th</sup> 2024 until 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2025
Winter holidays: December 21<sup>st</sup> 2024 until 6<sup>th</sup> January, 2025

Exam period takes place during semester break (non-teaching weeks).
